

Infinite infringement



In *F.B.T. Productions, LLC v. Let Them Eat Vinyl Distribution Ltd* [2019] EWHC 829 (IPEC), HHJ Hacon confirmed that copyright in the sound recording of the original album released by Eminem, known as 'Infinite', was owned by the Claimant and that the First Defendant had infringed that copyright by manufacturing and selling vinyl copies of it, notwithstanding a purported licence from a third party known as Shay Boogs trading as Boogie Up. The Claimant failed in a secondary infringement claim against the Second Defendant, the court finding that the requisite knowledge, actual or constructive, was absent. The court awarded injunctive relief against both Defendants and gave directions for disclosure to enable election for a trial of quantum.
